Applicants must have Grade Point 3.50 in Biology in 'A' Level/12 class completion equivalent examination. However, a GPA score of less than 4.00 points in any single exam will not be considered
- (vi) For calculating GPA against the percentage of marks obtained in O' level or other equivalent exam only top 5 subjects are considered.
- (vii) For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered.
- (viii) Age limit – Maximum 22 Years on 01 July 2025.
- (ix) Marital status – Unmarried.
- (x) Candidate must be physically fit and medical certificate by registered doctor is to be submitted.

Please be informed that the Directorate General of Medical Education under Medical Education & Family Welfare division of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Bangladesh has announced admission of foreign students in Government Medical Colleges and Dental College/Units for the academic year 2025-2026. Total 224 seats are allocated for the foreign students in this year. Among these, 125 seats are allocated for SAARC countries, 99 seats are allocated for Non-SAARC countries under Bangladesh Government's scholarship program. Country-wise allocation of seats are as follows:

02. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare of Bangladesh will consider application of foreign students for admission in Government Medical Colleges/Dental College/Dental Units in Bangladesh.
03. Interested candidates should duly fill-up an application form and arrange all necessary documents. Template of application form is enclosed at Annexure 'A'.
04. List of government medical colleges/dental college/dental units of Bangladesh is enclosed at Annexure 'B'.
05. Criteria of application for foreign students are enclosed at Annexure 'C'.
06. Interested candidates have to submit the application form attached with all academic records and relevant documents which must be sent to their respective ministry of foreign affairs/responsible authorities from 11th November, 2025 to 22nd December, 2025. Respective Ministry of foreign affairs/responsible authority of the country will verify the documents according to admission criteria mentioned in Annexure 'C' and will make an eligible list of students and send all documents to the ministry of foreign affairs of Bangladesh within 08th January, 2026. The ministry of foreign affairs of Bangladesh will send the documents regarding foreign student admission to the Directorate General of Medical Education and informed to medical education and family welfare division of the ministry of health and family welfare with in 15th January, 2026. No application will be considered after the deadline.

07. Candidates have to submit recent passport size photograph, passport, all academic documents (certificate and marks sheet of 'O' level/10 class completion exam and 'A' level/12 class completion exam). All submitted academic documents should be attested by Ministry of Education and Ministry of Foreign affairs of the respective countries and must be authenticated by the Embassy of Bangladesh of the concerned country. Eligible applicants must submit the attested documents to Bangladesh mission to obtain visa.
02. The applicants must have at least aggregated GPA 8.50 (Eight point Five zero) in 'O' level and 'A' level exam of individual GPA 5.00 (Five) scale. Applicants also must have Grade Point 3.50 in Biology in 'A' level/12 class completion equivalent examination. **However, a GPA score of less than 4.00 points in any single exam will not be considered.**
08. Detailed information of marks equalization is enclosed in Annexure 'D'.
09. All original certificates, mark sheets and relevant documents should be submitted to the office of the principal of respective government medical colleges/dental college/dental units of Bangladesh at the time of admission.
10. Admission will be continued into respective medical colleges/dental college/dental units from 22th February, 2026 to 14th March, 2026. Students must follow the rules and regulations of the college, hostel and hospital authorities.
11. Fabrication of any documents in the admission process is subjected to cancelation of admission which will be punishable under law. If any information or document or procedure is found fictitious in future, the admission will be void immediately and the ministry of health & family welfare of Bangladesh will not bear any responsibility.
12. 'National Policy for Admission of Students to MBBS and BDS Courses in the 2025-2026 Academic Year' by Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BM&DC) will be applicable.
13. The decision of admission committee (2025-2026) will be final in any matter for admission in medical colleges/dental college/units in Bangladesh.

Criteria for Admission of Foreign Students in the MBBS and BDS Courses in Government Medical Colleges/Dental College / Dental Units in Bangladesh for 2025-2026 academic year.

- A) Academic Records:
- Must have passed qualifying examination of 'O' level or equivalent examination and 'A' level or equivalent examination with science background.
 - 'O' level or equivalent examination passed not before 2022.
 - 'A' level or equivalent examination passed in the year of 2024 or 2025.
 - 'A' level or equivalent exam must be completed within 3 years of 'O' level or equivalent exam.
 - The applicants must have at least aggregated GPA 8.50 (Eight point Five zero) in 'O' level and 'A' level exam of individual GPA 5.00 (Five) scale. Applicants also must have Grade Point 3.50 in Biology in 'A' level/12 class completion equivalent examination. **However, a GPA score of less than 4.00 points in any single exam will not be considered.**
- B) For calculating GPA against the percentage of marks obtained in 'O' level or other equivalent exam only top 5 subjects are considered.
- C) For calculation of GPA against the marks obtained in 'A' level or equivalent exam, only 3 subjects (Physics, Chemistry and Biology) are considered.
- D) All certificates must be duly attested by the competent authority, i.e. Education and the Foreign Ministries of the respective countries and must be authenticated by the Embassy of Bangladesh of the concerned country.
- E) Tuition Fees: For Government medical and dental colleges, students from SAARC countries will require to pay tuition and other fees at the rate charged to a Bangladeshi student. Students from other countries will have to pay \$5000 (five thousand) per year in addition to the tuition fees charged for Bangladeshi student. If students can't pass in the exam in due time additional charges have to pay.
- F) 'National Policy for Admission of Students to MBBS and BDS Courses in the 2025-2026 Academic Year' by Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council (BM&DC) will be applicable.



Equivalence & Eligibility

Equivalence: Mark sheet of 'O' level /10 class completion exam and 'A' level/12 class completion exam will be considered. For 'O' Level exam mark sheet of top 5(five) subjects will be considered and for 'A' level exam marks of Biology, Chemistry & Physics will be considered.

Preparing merit list: First of all applicant's Grade Point Average (GPA/CGPA) of 'O' level and 'A' level will be cumulated. In case of equal GPA/CGPA, individual highest grade point of Biology, Chemistry and Physics of 'A' level will be considered respectively. When the said equation will be same, then total aggregation of obtained marks of Biology, Chemistry and Physics will be considered. When the total aggregation of three subjects will be same, then the senior applicant (age according to date of birth) will get preference.
