# MILITARY INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (MIST) INFORMATION BOOKLET

## Introduction

- 1. Military Institute of Science and Technology (MIST) is a government run technological institute under Ministry of Defence. It was established in 1998. The essence underlying the foundation of the institute includes commitment to the provision of technical leadership and development of indigenous technology for the Armed Forces and for the relevant cross section of the civil society of home and abroad. MIST is located at Mirpur Cantonment on the north-western end of Dhaka city. At present 14% military and 86% civilian students are studying here. So far MIST received students from 10 (ten) friendly countries.
- The institute sets out its academic curriculum as an affiliated body of the Bangladesh University of Professionals (BUP) to conduct undergraduate programs in Civil Engineering (CE), Computer Science and Engineering (CSE), Electrical, Electronic and Communication Engineering (EECE), Mechanical Engineering (ME), Aeronautical Engineering (AE) and Naval Architecture & Marine Engineering (NAME). A student of MIST is registered in the affiliating university for 6 years and is required to follow the terms and conditions as set by the university.

#### Aim

3. The aim of this paper is to articulate in details about the policy for admission and study of Foreign Students in MIST.

# Eligibility for Admission

- 4. <u>General</u>. Foreign students, seeking admission in MIST, may apply to the Armed Forces Division (AFD) of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (trg\_dte@afd.gov.bd). The general requirements are as follows:
  - a. Fluency in English language (medium of instruction in MIST is English).
  - b. Medically fit.
  - c. Sex Male or Female.
  - d. Having security clearance from respective Embassy/ High Commission in Bangladesh.
- 5. <u>Engineering Programs</u>. The candidates are to fulfill following requirements for admission in the engineering programs:
  - a. Candidates must have passed Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) (or equivalent) examination in Science group with minimum First Division or GPA 4 on a scale of 5 points in both the cases (in exceptional cases, the marks or GPA may be reduced to 50% or 3 respectively).

- b. In HSC (or equivalent) examination, the candidates have to score minimum grade 'A' in any 02 (two) subjects out of 04 (four) subjects (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English) and minimum 'A-' (A minus) grade in rest 02 (two) subjects (in exceptional cases, grading may reduced to 'B' or equivalent).
- c. For `O' Level/ Junior Cambridge and `A' Level/ Senior Cambridge background students, the candidates must have to qualify minimum 5 subjects in `O' Level/ Junior Cambridge and 3 subjects including Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry in `A' Level/ Senior Cambridge with minimum `B' grade in all subjects.
- d. In case of other types of certifications from foreign institutions, MIST will determine the equivalence.

### Academic Activities

- 6. <u>Duration of Programs</u>. The duration of engineering programs includes a total of 4 Levels (04 years), each comprising of 2 regular terms in a year.
- 7. Academic Schedule. MIST strictly maintains a yearly academic schedule, which is almost similar for every year. The scheduled activities are normally planned from January/ February to November/December each year except for the Level-4 students of all departments and the Level-1 Civil Engineering students. The Level-4 students of all departments are required to work for thesis/ projects/ internship in December and January and the Level-1 Civil Engineering students are to undertake "Survey Practical" works during the said period.

# Miscellaneous Points

- 8. <u>Requirement of Documents for Admission</u>. Notarized/ Attested copies of the following documents in English (or its authorized translated version) are to be enclosed with application duly filled in:
  - a. Certificate and mark sheet of Secondary School Certificate (SSC)/ 'O' level or equivalent examination.
  - b. Certificate and mark sheet of Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC)/ 'A' level or equivalent examination.
  - c. 08 (Eight) copies of recent 3.5 x 4.5 cm size colored photographs.
- 9. <u>Transportation</u>. Transportation in Dhaka city may be provided only for official use occasionally and subject to the availability.
- 10. <u>Medical</u>. Medical facilities will be provided to military student officers in Combined Military Hospital (CMH) and also civilian students in MIST Medical Center according to the existing medical policy of MIST.

- 11. <u>Accommodation and Food</u>. MIST, in principle is a residential institute. MIST offers accommodation and fooding facilities both for military (male/female) and civil (male/female) students.
  - a. <u>Military Students Officers</u>. MIST offers accommodation facilities to both bachelor and married officers, as offered to Bangladeshi Military Officers. Student Officers' Mess is under Wi-Fi internet coverage. MIST Student Officers' Mess also provides dining service for the residents on individual payment basis.
  - b. <u>Civilian Students</u>. MIST offers a modern residential hall named 'Osmany Hall' for the civilian students. Moreover, MIST also has foreign student accommodation with all modern facilities. It has male and female wings. Rooms in 'Osmany Hall' have internet browsing facilities. Fooding facilities are available in both the wings of the 'Osmany Hall' where students can have their daily messing on individual payment basis.

#### **Conduct and Discipline**

- 12. <u>General Rules and Regulations</u>. All students need to abide by the rules and regulations of MIST and affiliating university.
- 13. <u>Withdrawal</u>. Policy for withdrawal of foreign students from any program will be as per "Students Withdrawal Policy of MIST".
- 14. <u>Uniform/Dress</u>. All students will put on dresses as per "Dress Code" set by MIST.
